

Commissioner Kirk Perkins

Kirk Perkins, a Democrat, is serving his second term on the Guilford County Board of Commissioners. He was elected to serve District 4 in 2004 and re-elected in 2008. He also served as the Chairman of the Board in 2008.

A native of Guilford County and a graduate of Northeast High School, he earned a Bachelor of Arts in Administration of Criminal Justice from Guilford College. Commissioner Perkins and his wife Nancy live on their farm in McLeansville. His son Todd, daughter-in-law Marsha and grandsons Logan and Carson live in Winston-Salem.



Commissioner Perkins is the owner of Perkins and Associates, a real estate appraisal, construction and brokerage firm. He is a North Carolina State-Certified Residential Real Estate Appraiser, a North Carolina Real Estate Broker and a North Carolina Licensed General Contractor. He is a member of the Greensboro Builders Association and the Greater Greensboro Realtors Association. Prior to starting his own business, he worked for the North Carolina Department of Corrections.

He serves as a liaison for the Board of Commissioners on the Agricultural Advisory Board, Greensboro Transportation Advisory Committee, and the Parks and Recreation Commission. Perkins also serves on the Board's Jail Construction Advisory Committee.
